Ages: 2017-2018 Select players' birthdates must fall between 1999 – 2005.

Registration Fee: \$250.00. Covers training, facility costs, coaches fee, player registration, and insurance.

Uniform Costs: \$95.00 (black jersey, white jersey, white shorts, black socks & white socks) for those players that need to order a Select Uniform.

Refunds: Refunds are considered but require approval of the Select Advisory Board. The general policy is that there is no refund available to a player once the teams have been formed; however, requests may be made, in writing, to the Club Administrator state your case. The Select Advisory Board will review and provide a recommended decision on all refunds to the BFC Executive Board and WYSA Board of Directors. Typically, refunds are granted in the event of a long-term injury, a player leaving the area, or other unforeseen circumstances.



Events

The goal of the Select program is to attend on average one event per month from December to July. We will offer five indoor tournaments and four outdoor tournaments (see attached schedule).

Elite Development Program

As a committee, we have decided to offer an Elite Development Program. Each age group (U15-U19) will select three to four players to be part of the Elite Development Team. This team will attend the GSI Showcase in Wisconsin Dell, WI on June 22-24, 2018. They will be coached by the Director of Coaching (DOC) with four to six extra **mandatory** training sessions. These sessions will be run by the DOC and two to four assistant coaches in Watertown and Brookings. We will announce this team May 20th.

There will be an additional cost for those that have been selected for the team of \$125.00 this will cover the tournament entry fee, coach's fees, informational pamphlet for college coaches and a tournament jersey.

We will also be offering a college bound seminar, this will be open to the entire club with an emphasis on what it means to be a student athlete at the collegiate level. (Time and place TBA)
